I hereby declare that notice has been given to the Herald Times, the Atlantic City Press and posted on the bulletin board of the Middle Township Municipal Building, stating the time and place of the following meeting as required in P.L. 1975, Chapter 231 of the State of New Jersey (Sunshine Law).

The Middle Township Board of Health met on the above date at 6:00 PM in the Middle Township Meeting Room. Regular meeting night. Members present were Mayor Donohue, Committeemember Lockwood, Committeemember Clark, Sean McDevitt and Cape May County Representative Lilli Palin. *Sarah Sharpe was absent.*

1. VIOLATIONS –
 - a. Pat's Lunch – 1105 Stone Harbor Boulevard - Summons issued by Cape May County Health Department for selling food in an unsanitized establishment.

2.
