Both cases were health care providers with recent travel to the Arabian Peninsula. While neither case had connections with New Jersey, they do serve as a reminder that it is likely that at some point in time, New Jersey will have a case.
 - b. July 3, 2014 - Summary of New Jersey Animal Rabies Cases by County and Species for January 1 through June 30, 2014. Summary indicates that County Rabies Baiting program is very effective.
