EMERGENCY MEETING
FLAG SALUTE
THIS MEETING IS BEING RECORDED:

This Emergency Meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meeting Law. Adequate notice was not provided due to the nature of the urgency and importance of said emergency. The nature of the substantial harm to the public interest likely to result from a delay in the holding of said meeting and this meeting will be limited to discussion of and acting with respect to such matters of urgency and importance. Discussion was held in connection with the snow emergency and removal of such. This meeting was held in the second floor conference room of 33 Mechanic Street, Cape May Court House, NJ, otherwise known as Township Hall at 3:00pm.

Members present were Mayor DeLanzo, Mayor DeLanzo, Committeemember Lockwood, Business Administrator Mark Mallett, Solicitor James Pickering, and Township Clerk Kimberly Tomkinson. Also present were Capt. Paul Fritsch, Lt. John Edwards, and Andrew Smith of Public Works.

Mark Mallett discussed how much the latest snow storm has cost the township. He indicated that so far the total is \$177,000. This amount included \$53,000.00 for the emergency shelter, \$12,000.00 in Police OT, \$113,000.00 in Public Works OT. This public works amount includes \$64,000.00 from outside contractors. This does not include parts for vehicles from damage.

Andrew Smith proposed 6-7 times more trees and debris from storm to be picked up.

M. Mallett stated that a resolution is to be proposed after the March 1 meeting for emergency contractors.

Committeemember Lockwood asked if money was received from last storm.

M. Mallett indicated \$15,000.00

Andrew Smith stated that the public works crew was very thankful for the meals. They are up to 85% where they should be and is concerned with icing and basins destroyed. Will be reassessing the town a week after the storm.

Discussion was held regarding tree/branch pick up from storm.

Mayor DeLanzo asked particulars for State of Emergency vs. Disaster.

There being no further business the emergency meeting was adjourned at 4:00pm.
