Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Madelyn Mc Carroll. Flag salute was made.  
Attendance as follows:

Absent: Captain Edwards; Mary Creamer; Suzann Callinan; George Spadea and Dawn Stimmel.  
In the absence of Dawn Stimmel, Vilma Pombo took minutes.

MINUTES OF LAST MEETING: To be corrected per Madelyn.

Agenda: Madelyn reviewed items on list of activities briefly. Schedule of events with dates to follow.  
Priorities of Spay/Neuter and Animal Cruelty - e.g. future rabies clinics, tabling events, homework club,  
Signage for the park and Hot Cars, Officer Bill videos. Grants, etc.

Bill Candell ACO, gave reports of 2 rabid raccoons in M.T. as well as a report of rabies vaccine crop by  
Cape May Co. The current dog census is ongoing as time permits staffing. Co. report on dog bites was  
and unlicensed dogs was also reviewed. No Officer Bill videos have been made yet. (Karen Buckingham  
offered the use of a commercial cooler for videos) Madelyn advised that Pet Smart Grant was not received  
this year but there are other possibilities. She and Dawn are working on forms etc.

Rick Eufrazio is still working on Trust Account issues as well a "Hot Car" vehicle. May need to solicit funds  
From businesses in Township. He is also working on "Code Blue" same as for homeless people but for  
animals. Code Red for summer is ongoing with a review with all patrolmen/women and information for the  
general public.

Madelyn also addressed signage at the Park ; the 4-H Fair and BARC that was held at the Rec. Center on  
April 18<sup>th</sup>. Suzann; Rick and Mary were there and the event was well attended.

Jen Modica reported on Webinar information that would be useful to all members. This type of Social  
Media training will be ongoing.

Madelyn then reviewed additional information on Grants, OPRA request pending for info on calls for animal  
issues, HSUS priorities, Feral Cat Networking, Creating guidelines for zoning inforcement, Compliance with  
puppy lemon laws and Payment of sales State and Federal taxes, tabling ideas, Campground animal  
issues etc. She also advised that the 1<sup>st</sup> reading of the Ordinance amending Dogs and Other animals was  
completed and passed on April 20, 2015. The second reading and consideration for adoption will be made  
on May 18, 2015 .

Other: Karen Buckingham advised students are making 1 minute videos which will be aired soon.  
Madelyn addressed establishment of an Animal Cruelty Team consisting of Judges, Lawyers, Social  
Workers and ACO officers. She also said Lissie volunteered to head the TNR Committee and will provide  
additional info in the future. Madelyn and Suzann are still working on the May meeting and get together  
at the Park with other animal groups joining us there.
