

To further improve reliability for more than 7,000 customers in Middle Township, North Wildwood, and the surrounding area, Atlantic City Electric will be rebuilding and modernizing its power lines in Middle Township this summer. These upgrades will strengthen the company's energy infrastructure to withstand more severe storms and hurricanes.

To safely complete this work, Atlantic City Electric is required to close a portion of the bike path from Indian Trail Road to Hand Avenue in Middle Township beginning June 17 through September 13, weather permitting. Atlantic City Electric is committed to minimizing the potential impacts of this work on the local community during the summer months and appreciates the understanding of residents and visitors as its crews and contractors work to enhance reliability for residents and businesses.

This work is part of PowerAhead, Atlantic City Electric's strategic grid resiliency initiative to modernize and enhance energy infrastructure in areas that have experienced outages during severe storms. Between 2017 and 2022, the company will enhance the resiliency of the grid and perform necessary system upgrades through this targeted initiative across portions of its service area.
