Please allow this letter to serve as notice of the following revisions to the Cape May County Recycling Program. Due to limited end markets and increased contamination potential, **bulky mixed rigid plastics and shredded paper** have been removed from the County's "Recommended" and "Designated" recyclables list, respectively. **Effective October 1, 2019**, all **bulky mixed rigid plastics** (all hard plastics regardless of size and color; examples include plastic laundry baskets, plastic toys and playhouses, plastic lawn furniture, empty plastic trashcans, and plastic coolers) **and shredded paper** will no longer be accepted at the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority Intermediate Processing Facility. Therefore, all **bulky mixed rigid plastics and shredded paper** shall be disposed of as trash.
