WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Middle is charged with protecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Township of Middle; and  
WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, through Executive Order No.103, the facts and circumstances of which are adopted by reference herein, the Governor of the State of New Jersey declared both a public health emergency and a State of Emergency throughout the State due to the public health hazard posed by Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID –19); and

WHEREAS, thereafter, on March 21, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order No. 107, the facts and circumstances of which are also adopted herein, by reference, which established social mitigation strategies for combating COVID 19; and

WHEREAS, subsequently and also on March 21, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order No. 108, which recognizes that there are certain limited circumstances in which it may be in a beneficial for localities to be able to impose additional restrictions and specifically identified that certain municipalities may have legitimate concerns about an influx of new visitors, which may cause public

health concerns as the state imposes social distancing measures and aims to avoid unnecessary increases in the density of individuals; and  
WHEREAS, campgrounds within the Township of Middle have been affected by the various restrictions on travel and occupancy imposed during this period; and  
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 104-15 of the Code of the Township of Middle, campgrounds are required to close on or before November 1 of each year; and  
WHEREAS due to COVID related difficulties King Nummy Campground and Sea Pines Campground have requested relief from the provisions of the ordinance for calendar year 2020; and  
WHEREAS due to the extenuating circumstances experienced during this COVID pandemic the Township Committee, the Governing Body of the Township of Middle, deems it to be equitable and just to grant such relief;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLE, AS FOLLOWS:

1.
