MIDDLE TOWNSHIP RECYCLING DEPOT

ACCEPTED: Paper, Cardboard, Cans, Bottles, Motor Oil, Electronics, (4) Tires a year.

Items are able to be dropped off behind the Public Works Building.

NOT ACCEPTED: Trash, Paint, Thinners or Solvents, Pesticides, Propane Tanks, Anti-Freeze, Gasoline.

RECYCLE CANS 32 GALLON CONTAINER OR LESS

Recycle cans **MUST** be labeled with a "Single Stream Recycling" label.

Recycle cans and labels are available at Public Works.

TRASH CANS

NO BIGGER THEN A 50 GALLON CONTAINER

Regular household trash should preferably be placed in receptacles. This item is **NOT** provided by the Township.

HOLIDAYS

Trash and Recyclables will be picked up curbside every Holiday for the year 2024, EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING: Thanksgiving Day (2024) Christmas Day (2024) New Year's Day (2025)

WHAT ZONE ARE YOU IN?

All items Trash and Recycling will be collected on your regular scheduled days. Your Trash and Recycle days are organized by **ZONE.**

WHAT TO DO WITH YARD WASTE

GRASS CLIPPINGS - Grass Clippings are best disposed of by the "cut it and leave it" method. Bagged grass clippings will be picked up curbside. **PLACE CLIPPINGS IN BROWN BAGS OR OPEN CONTAINERS.**

TREE BRANCHES AND BRUSH - No longer than 6-8 ft. in length and free of roots and soil, place in an orderly fashion with all cut ends facing roadway clear of trees, electrical wires and mailboxes.

BRANCHES CAN NOT BE IN BROWN BAGS. PLACE ITEMS ON THE CURB OR IN OPEN CONTAINERS.

LEAVES - Bagged in BROWN BAGS or OPEN CONTAINERS for all months.



CHRISTMAS TREES - Please make sure the tree has all decorations and stand removed. Put to curbside for pickup. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Tree roots, stumps & logs are NOT collected by the Township. Please contact CMCMUA or a local Class B Recycling Facility for disposal.
- These services are provided to established residences ONLY AND does not apply to clearing of underdeveloped property.

BULK LEAF PICKUP

November - January

Raked leaves in **BULK** can be picked up curbside.

Piles must be free of branches and trash and 2ft from curb and storm basins.

WE CAN NOT COLLECT LEAVES IF THERE ARE TWIGS, DEBRIS, DIRT OR STONES MINGLED IN WITH THE LEAVES.

TRASH AND RECYCLE

Gold Medal Environmental (GME) will pick up Trash & Recyclables (Monday - Friday). Trash and recycling should be neatly displayed and accessible for pick up CURBISDE ONLY.

THE NIGHT BEFORE AFTER 5:00 PM
OR BEFORE 6:00 AM THE DAY OF

After pickup, **REMOVE** the empty cans to the rear or side of property.



- **BULK ITEMS** Furniture One Room Size Rug rolled, cut and tied up. **No longer than 4-6 feet including padding.**
- Household items that are NOT metal.
 Mattress and Box Spring (Together = 1 Item) BOTH ITEMS MUST BE WRAPPED IN PLASTIC.

Residents are permitted to dispose of ONE bulk item PER MONTH. BULK TRASH PICK UP

Items have to be placed by the curb THE NIGHT BEFORE AFTER 5:00 PM or BEFORE 6:00 AM on pickup day.

Middle Township Public Works reminds residents that bulk pickup always takes place during the last trash pickup of the month.

UNLESS that trash day falls on a holiday, in which case it would occur the following day.

HOW TO "DISPOSE" OF

APPLIANCES Refrigerators, Freezers, Stoves, Dishwashers, Air Conditioners, Microwaves, Vacuums, or any METAL ITEMS.

PLEASE TAKE ITEMS TO: The Transfer Station or CMCMUA.

ELECTRONICS TV's, Monitors, Computers, Printers, Radios, Stereos, VCRs, Telephone Systems, ECT.

ITEMS CAN BE: Placed curbside for Township pick-up, brought to the Public Works building, taken to the Transfer Station or CMCMUA.

USED MOTOR OIL Must be put into a clear container (no bigger than a gallon plastic jug) with a tight-fitting lid and labeled.

USED MOTR OIL CANNOT BE MIXED WITH ANTIFREEZE.

ITEMS CAN BE: Placed curbside for Township pick-up, brought to the Public Works building, taken to the Transfer Station or CMCMUA.

CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS Dry Wall, Lumber or pieces of wood, Shingles, Windows, Screens, Doors, Floor Tile, Asphalt, Concrete, Cinder Block, Brick, ECT. THESE ITEMS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR OR PROPERTY OWNER TO DISPOSE OF.

AUTO BATTERIES Picked up curbside by the Township recycling truck.

PROPANE TANKS Propane tanks are <u>not</u> picked up by the Township or Gold Medal. Contact CMCMUA.

PAINT Latex paint can be opened and allowed to dry out to be put in the trash. All empty paint cans are trash, they CAN NOT be recycled. REMEMBER, THE BEST WAY TO GET RID OF PAINT IS TO USE IT UP.

HYPODERMIC NEEDLES Must be rendered inoperable according to State Law (tip broken off). Free containers are offered through the "Safe Disposal Program" At Cape Regional Medical Center. Call: 609-463-2273

AUTO TIRES (4) Per Residence Per Year. ITEMS CAN BE: Placed curbside for Township pick-up or taken to CMCMUA.

GASOLINE Hazardous Waste Disposal Days ONLY. Contact CMCMUA.

RECYCLE PROCEDURE

PAPER

RECYCLE: Newspaper with inserts, magazines, office paper, brown paper bags, telephone and paperback books, pamphlets, cardboard boxes, clean pizza boxes, dry food boxes (cereal, cracker, pasta - remove all liner bags), beer and soda carriers and non-foil wrapping paper. All materials must be clean.

Large cardboard boxes should be flattened. Free of packing popcorn, plastic and wood.

DO NOT RECYCLE: Shredded paper, carbon paper, paper plates, milk or juice cartons, napkins, paper towels, tissues or newspapers that are soiled.

ALUMINUM CANS & BI-METAL CANS

RECYCLE: Aluminum, Steel (Tin), Food, Beverage and Aerosol Cans (5 Gallons in side or less). **DO NOT RECYCLE:** Cans that contained paint thinner or chemical solvents, paint cans, aluminum foil, aluminum trays or pie pans.

GLASS

RECYCLE: Food and Beverage Glass Containers -Clear, Green and Brown Bottles, Jars and Jugs. **DO NOT RECYCLE**: Dishes, drinking glasses, window glass, pottery or ceramics and light bulbs.

PLASTICS

RECYCLE: #1 Through #7 Plastic Bottles and Containers including: food and beverage containers, health, beauty and cleaning product containers. Other rigid plastic contains including buckets and landscape pots (5 gallons in size or less).

DO NOT RECYCLE: Any plastic bottles that contained antifreeze, motor oil, or petroleum auto products.

Please RINSE containers, REMOVE caps and lids, DO NOT flatten containers.

For Disposal Of: Oil-based paints, thinners and solvents, gasoline, automotive products, pesticides and herbicides, glues/adhesives, mercury-containing items, pool chemicals, fluorescent bulbs. Please Call CMCMUA for all questions.
